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Beaded Wool Scarf

designed by Barbara Lundy Stone

MATERIALS: Choose any three colors (1 Skein each)

EQUIPMENT: Size 9 knitting needles large tapestry needle

GAUGE: 4st/in

DIRECTIONS: Cast on 35 stitches.

Knit in garter stitch using each color for two rows.

Begin with the Metallic color and use this color every other time throughout. Repeat each block as desired before moving to the next block. The blocks should be random sizes and the scarf should not end where it began.

Block one: Alternate the metallic (colorA) and color B (ABAB)

Block two: transition block. Make sure that you use the metallic every other time . Add color C

(ACAB).

Block three: (ACAC).

Block four: (ABAC).

Repeat these four blocks until you run out of the metallic yarn. Cast off and weave in ends.

Single crochet around the entire piece.

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
