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Mohair and Wool Seed Poncho - Woodpath

MATERIALS:

- 2 skeins Wool Seed
- 2 skeins Mohair

EQUIPMENT:

- Size 13 circular knitting needles
- crochet hook
- large tapestry needle

SIZE: medium

DIRECTIONS: Cast on 56 stitches with both yarns held together. Knit 1 row placing a marker at the beginning and halfway around.

INCREASE PATTERN: Increase one stitch before the markers, knit the stitch after the markers, and increase one stitch.

Knit in stockinette stitch in the round. Make one row with increases and one row without. Continue until there are 200 stitches on your needle and cast off. Knit loosely and encourage the seeds to migrate to the outside.

NECK BORDER: With just the wool seed and from the inside single crochet four rows around the neck decreasing one sc at the front and back V each round.

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BOTTOM BORDER: With the wool seed and from the inside single crochet two rows around the bottom. Weave in ends.
