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Sedona Shell

## MATERIALS:

- 1 skein Early Meadow Rayon Metallic
- 1 skein Copper Rayon Metallic

#### **EQUIPMENT:**

- Size 6 knitting needles
- Size G crochet hook
- large tapestry needle

GAUGE: 5st/7rows/in chest size 38" length 21 1/2"

DIRECTIONS: Cast on 105 st with Early Meadow and knit 1row. Tie on

Copper and begin row 1. Alternate 2 rows each color.

BACK: Row 1: Knit 3, p 99, k 3.

Row2: Knit

Repeat for 19" (72 ribs.)

NECK OPENING: Row 1: K3, p99, k3.

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Row 2: K 40, cast off 25, k 40.
Row 3: K 3, p34, k3.
Row 4: Knit.
Repeat rows 3 & 4 until there are 39 ribs. Make both sides .
Row 5: K3, p34, k3, cast on 25, k3, p34, k3.
Row 6: Knit.
Row7: K3, p99, k3.
FRONT: Knit rows 6 & 7 until there are 53 ribs and cast off.
FINISHING: Row 1:Without breaking the yarn *sc, ch 1, sk 1 st, sc in next st *.
Repeat along the front edge, 2 sc in the corner, sc in between ribs along the side, 2
sc in the corner. Make the back the same as the front and the 2nd side the same as
the first.
Row 2: Sc, ch 2, sc in each ch 1 space along the front, 2 sc in the corner and sl st
into the sc along the side. Repeat for the back and 2nd side. Beginning at the front
make rows 1 & 2 the same.
JOINING: Beginning 8" from the top lace the sides together. Sew into the back
loops only. Weave in ends.
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
