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Sedona Sunset Shawl

### **MATERIALS:**

- 1 skein Early Meadow Rayon Metallic
- 1 skein Melon-Confetti- use both as one
- 1 skein Copper Rayon Metallic
- 1 skein Heather- Confetti- use both as one

# **EQUIPMENT:**

- Size 10 1/2 knitting needles
- Size J crochet hook
- large tapestry needle

GAUGE: 3 1/2st/6rows/in -length 72" -width 15"+ fringe

DIRECTIONS: Cast on 50 stitches with the RM and CF together Early Meadow & Melon -

Color A). Knit 1 row.

Row 1/2: Knit with color B (Copper & Heather).

Row 3/4: Knit with color A.

Repeat until there are 170 ribs and cast off. Do not break yarn.

FINISHING: With the J hook sI st along the bottoms and sc into the spaces between the ribs.

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FRINGE: With all yarns wind 20" lengths for the fringe (I wind around a 10" book). Use 6

threads for each knot and put 1 in every other sc in the ends and along one long side.

Enjoy your shawl!

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
