# Shop > Vests > Water Hyacinth Vest and Scarf



Water Hyacinth Vest and Scarf

- 2 skeins Water Hyacinth Silk/Rayon Twist
- 1 skein Water Hyacinth Cotton/Rayon Seed

### **EQUIPMENT:**

- Size 10-1/2 knitting needles
- Size I crochet hook
- Size K crochet hook
- large tapestry needle

DIRECTIONS: Cast on 125(85-short) stitches with the silk/ray. Knit side to side.

Unit One: Knit two rows of garter stitch with the silk/rayon.

Unit Two: Knit two rows in garter stitch with the cotton/rayon seed.

Alternate between unit one and unit two until there are 15 repeats.

Knit 1 row with the silk/rayon

VEST BACK: Next row. Cast off 66(46) stitches, knit 59(39).

Unit Two 1 X.

Alternate between Unit One and Unit Two 6 X.

Side Two: Next row. Knit 59(39) stitches, cast on 66(46) stitches with silk/rayon. Knit 1

row.

Unit Two 1 X.
Alternate between Unit One and Unit Two 15 X.
NECK BAND: Starting at the bottom front edge make one half-double crochet in each
stitch along the front, 13 stitches along the neck back and in each stitch along the other
front edge. Turn, and make 4 more rows of half-double crochet. Turn, and with K
crochet hook slip stitch into each crochet stitch. Turn, and make one more slip stitch
row.
FINISHING SIDES: Lay the vest inside out with the sides together. Measure 13" (10")
from the fold. Slip stitch along the sides with the silk/rayon 4" (2"). For the short vest
add a 14" fringe using both yarns together.
SCARF:
With size 10-1/2 needles cast on 18 stitches. Knit in Garter stitch for 65". Cast off and
weave in ends.
