Galaxy Flounced Scarf

Size 1 (2) Finished size approx 5" x 64 (80)"

Materials: 4 (5) Galaxy
Needles size 15 or size to get gauge

Gauge: in garter st, 10 sts & 20 rows = 4"

CO 12 sts.

In garter stitch, work short rows as follows:

* K 10, yfwd, slip 1, yb, slip st back to left hand
needle, turn (w & t made),

K 10.

K 8, repeat w & t, k 8.

K 6, repeat w & t, k 6.

K 4, repeat w & t, k 4.

K 2, repeat w & t, k 2.

K 2, insert needle into wrap around next st and lift
it onto left hand needle, k the wrap and the st tog;
work across, picking up all wraps.

K 1 row.*

Repeat ** to end of yarn, BO all sts.



Our flounced scarf is great fun to make and to wear! Big needles and 3/4" wide Galaxy knit up quickly--ready to wear in an evening or two. Garter stitch flounces are formed by working short rows. The scarf works up into a long spiral that wraps cleanly around your neck and then cascades down in a graceful fall.

This style can also be used for a nice ruffled collar, as can be seen on pattern 4202, made in narrower Flirt. Click on the cover of book 42 to view pattern 4202.

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
