YARN

COLOURSCAPE

2 x 100gm

(photographed in Spring 442)

NEEDLES

1 pair 7mm (no 2) (US 10½) needles

Cable needle

TENSION

14 sts and 18 rows to 10cm measured over st st using
7mm (US 10½) needles.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

C14F – slip next 7 sts onto a cable needle and hold at front of work, K7, then K7 from cable needle.

C14B – slip next 7 sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, K7, then K7 from cable needle.

Using 7mm (US 10½) needles cast on 25 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: K2, P21, K2.

Rows 3 to 6: Rep rows 1 and 2 twice.

Row 7: K9, C14F, K2.

Row 8: As row 2.

Rows 9 to 16: Rep rows 1 and 2, 4 times.

Row 17: K2, C14B, K9.

Row 18: As row 2.

Rows 19 and 20: As rows 1 and 2.

These 20 rows form patt.

Cont in patt as set until scarf meas approx 158cm, ending with row 4 or 14 and RS facing for next row.

Cast off.
