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Openwork Angora Scarf

Our lacy scarf is generous in size and soft as a cloud in 100% French Angora. We love it wrapped around the neck or tied loosely like a man's tie. An open stitch pattern makes the 90 yards go far enough for a really good sized scarf. Knit it in an evening!



One Size: Approx 4" x 50"

Materials:

1 skein Prism Angora (1 oz, 90 yds) in Fog
Needles size 11 or size to get gauge

Gauge:

In openwork stitch, 12 sts & 14 rows = 4"

Openwork stitch: even number sts

All rows: p 1, *p 2 tog, yo*, rep ** to end, p 1.

CO 12 sts. Work patt to last yd of yarn.

BO all sts loosely in patt.

Alternate stitch pattern:

The pattern can be worked in k 2 tog, yo instead of p 2 tog. The look will be slightly flatter but you may find it easier to work.

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
